NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Commissioners of the Authority deems that it is in the best interests of the Authority to purchase said property located at 1170 Market Street, Yuba City, California for the purpose of providing warehouse, maintenance yard and storage space for Housing Authority personnel, equipment and secure files.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Board of Commissioners approves the purchase of 1170 Market Street, Yuba City, California, and that escrow closes by February 5, 2015.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Board of Commissioners of the Regional Housing Authority of Sutter and Nevada authorizes the Executive Director as authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to consummate the purchase of 1170 Market Street, Yuba City, California.
